From an Impossible Challenge to a Reality

It started with Pastor Benoit, President of the Lutheran Church of Haiti, challenging Herb Nordmeyer to find a technology so disaster-resistant homes could be built for a material cost of not more than \$1,000 US. Herb failed, since the cost of a home which met UN standards to house 9 people came in at a material cost of \$2,800.

As time passed, with the help of countless others, he developed a 5-day intense course on disaster-resistant home building. Pictured are a few of the most recent class receiving their certificates at the end of the Reformation Sunday service at Bon Berger Lutheran Church in Port-au-Prince.



But Herb's recent time in Haiti was not only spent teaching the class. He also worked with four people as they earned their instructor certifications.
